The difference made in this poor community in the last five years is overwhelming. We appreciate all of you, our dear friends, sponsors and partners, that have made it possible for us to take care of these children in need and make such a great impact in our village.

This year's conference in May was very powerful! Over 10,000 people attended this

Ebenezer Christian Academy purposes to give children quality education with a Christian background...

The children population is growing at our school as the standard of Ebenezer Christian School

grows. We have now grown out of room.

However God has provided an alternative for this. Someone has opted to give us his piece of land for renting at \$150 every month. The only challenge we have is that we have to set up our own class room structures.

We have therefore decided to set up temporary classroom structures and a permanent toilet at a cost the monthly rent. We plan to of \$8000.

The advantage with this is that we shall save on the rent costs since we pay \$500 every month in rent for the present school building. But also we have agreed with the landlord that every permanent building we construct on his

Prayer Requests

- We still have a challenge of hundreds of children who have no opportunity to go to school.
- -It takes \$35 support per month for a child in primary school
- -It takes \$45 support per month, for a child in high school.
- -It takes \$150 support per month for a child in college.
- Many children still remain homeless. Pray with us that God will provide us with our own premises where we can accommodate more children.
- We need consistent support to run the operational costs of House of Hope Children Home.

- -It takes \$3000 per month for: feeding, rent, utilities, clothes, medical care, scholastic materials and staff wages.
- We plan to buy more land to grow our own food for the children home. We plan to buy 10 acres of land and each acrecosts @ \$4000.

- We plan to buy 2 more sweater weaving machines as one way to sustain the home @ \$6000.
