Transforming the Community

“We thank God for Revival Outreach Ministries,” said one of the community leaders at a government function. “Ever since this church started here, our community has changed”, he continued.

God has used our ministry to minister to so many children in need.. Hundreds of children loiter the streets in search of survival. You find them fighting for food in garbage bins. Young boys some times become thieves to survive. Girls on the other hand sometimes become

prostitutes because men promise them money and food in exchange for sex. These children normally would become single mothers at an early age. And the children they raise with no responsible fathers in turn go to the streets, because they cannot afford money to go to school and cannot look after their babies.

This cycle continues.

As a church we felt God called us to minister to these hurting children and make a difference in our community. Thank you all who pray for us and



support to us to be able to help these children.

A House of Hope

What a joy to see a smile on the faces of these wonderful children who would have otherwise been homeless. Most of these children lost their parents because of diseases like AIDs and Malaria. They loiter the streets in search of food, care and shelter. House of Hope children's home offers shelter, food, love and care for these precious children. This children's home provides an opportunity to groom desperate and destitute children into God fearing leaders that will transform communities!

We put together a conference every May to disciple these people. This years attendance of 10,000 people was by far the biggest.

About 500 gave their lives to Jesus! Many people were delivered from witchcraft and the powers of darkness.

We prayed for those who were sick and many received miracle healing! By the end of the week, the only talk in Kabale was that Jesus is Lord!

Over a hundred people have joined a church in our town according to reports. 50 of these are in our church. We have baptized 20 of the new converts.

I have one grandchild with a birthday of December 7th and one born on December 9th, so Moses fit in perfectly. From the time I sent in the application I felt a connection to Moses. I prayed for him every day along with my grandchildren. The first time I shopped for his birthday and Christmas gifts I was walking around the store and realized I didn't really know that much about Uganda. I didn't know what kind of weather they were having or if Moses could possibly need a jacket. I sent an email to Johnson and asked him if Moses needed a jacket. Before I left the store I had an answer back from Johnson. Don't you just love technology? That Christmas, Johnson posted pictures of the children having Christmas dinner together. I scanned the picture diligently looking for a glimpse of Moses. Sure enough, I found him. I would have recognized him anyway, but he was wearing one of the outfits I had sent him for his birthday. It was as if I had received a picture of one of my grandchildren. Sponsoring Moses has been such a blessing for our

whole family. Johnson is excellent at sending pictures when my packages arrive for Moses and I love getting every one of them.

October 2012, Johnson came to stay at our house for 11 days in order to speak at my church and 2 other churches in the area. That was such a wonderful blessing. Johnson happened to mention that Moses also has a little sister that needed a sponsor. I said, "Oh, Johnson don't do this to me", but then I saw her picture. I was hooked. Now we are doubly blessed with Moses and Vicky. Vicky has been first in her class for the last 2 years and I couldn't be more proud. I have received pictures of Moses leading singing in worship service and receiving the goat I bought for his family. I can't express enough what a wonderful blessing it is to sponsor these children. I love receiving their letters

Prayer Requests

- ◆ We still have a challenge of hundreds of children who have no opportunity to go to school.
 - It takes \$35 support per month for a child in primary school
 - It takes \$45 support per month, for a child in high school.
 - It takes \$150 support per month for a child in college.
- ◆ We need to buy our own land for Ebenezer Christian Academy @ \$40,000.
- ◆ We need \$2000 support per month to run Ebenezer Christian school consistently to pay staff and buy school supplies.
- ◆ We need consistent support to run the operational costs of House of Hope Children Home.
 - It takes \$2500 per month for: feeding, rent, utilities, clothes, medical care, scholastic materials and staff wages.
- ◆ We plan to buy more land to grow our own food for the children's home. We need 4 more acres of land to meet our target, and each acre costs @ \$4000.
- ◆ Pray that God will touch more people to join in to support our vision and transform our community.
- ◆ Pray for our children that they will grow in the grace of God.
