Ebenezer Christian School Second Year...



Our children are happy to be part of our Christian school...

Thank you all our friends who helped us with funds to pay for rent, we are now happily continuing to run our school.

This year we started Primary five (Grade 5). We thank God he has given us dedicated Christian teachers who are doing volunteer work for the biggest part.

It gives so much joy to a child in our community to go to school. Education develops the mind of a child to handle different challenges and be successful and effective in life. It is therefore important to educate a child in Uganda.

Revival Outreach Ministries offers hope for orphans and poor children in Uganda to go to school with a Christian perspective. Our goal is to produce godly future leaders who will bring about a change in our nation and communities.

\$35 a month is enough to make a dramatic change in the life of a precious child.

This money pays for school tuition, buys a school uniform and shoes once every year, meets medical fees and buys lunch.

Pray for us for provisions to continue to pay rent, the teachers and staff and buy school supplies.

Our dream is to buy land and build our own structures in the near future. *it*" (Prov. 22:6)

Gardening- A great Harvest...

This last season was the best ever. We were able to make a good harvest despite the heavy rains at the start of the season. We harvested corn that fed our children for several weeks. Our children love eating corn on the cob. We also harvested three sacks of beans (100kgs). With the escalating food prices, this has helped us to continue feeding our children with ease. We have also harvested ten sacks of potatoes (each is also100kgs). When our children came for the short Easter holiday, they said one of the things they were looking forward to was eating chips (French fries). We plan to harvest cassava sometime in July, it takes longer than other crops.

We are working on our garden again for the May planting season. We will plant more beans and potatoes.

We pray that God will provide more land so we can make a farm where we can grow more crops like bananas, fruits and vegetables.

Prayer Requests

- We still have a challenge of hundreds of children who have no opportunity to go to school.
 - -It takes \$35 support per month for a child in primary school.
 - -It takes \$45 support per month, for a child in high school.
 - -It takes \$150 support per month for a child in college.
- We need to pay house rent for the children's home for this year by May, Please pray for us and support us. We need \$2,400.
- We need consistent support to run the operational costs of House of Hope Children's Home.

- -lt takes \$2,500 per month for feeding, rent, utilities, clothes, medical care, scholastic materials and staff wages.
- We plan to buy more land to grow our own food for the children's home. We need 4 acres of land to meet our target, and each acre costs @ \$4,000.

- We need 2 more sweater weaving machines to achieve our goal of sustaining the home. @ \$6,000.
