Transforming the Community

It is amazing to see the great work God has done in our community in Kabale, Uganda in the last few years.

After hundreds of parents in our community died of diseases like AIDS and Malaria, they left behind so many children who need help.

Hundreds of children loiter the streets in search of survival. You find them fighting for food in garbage bins. Young boys some times become thieves to survive, girls on the other hand sometimes become prostitutes because men promise them money and food in exchange for sex. These children normally would become single mothers at an early age. And the children they raise with no responsible fathers in turn go to the streets, because they cannot afford money to go to school and cannot look after their babies.

This cycle continued.

As a church we felt God called us to

minister to these hurting children.

We started to pick these children from the streets and eventually began a children's home for the homeless children.

We started to take these children to school because we believe that education unlocks a child's potential and God given abilities to make him successful in life.

Touching and changing the lives of these children through education is a step to stop the cycle and transform our community and as a result impact the next generation.

It gives so much joy to a child in our community to go to school.

Today, some of the children we started with, have graduated from school and have jobs.

talked with some business people in Kampala, and they are willing to buy our sweaters! This is exciting! When we get established, we plan to teach this skill to all the children, so that we can employ some of the children who show interest after school.

We need two more machines to achieve our goal. Each machine costs \$6000.

Prayer Requests

- We still have a challenge of hundreds of children who have no opportunity to go to school.
 - -It takes \$35 support per month for a child in primary school
 - -lt takes \$45 support per month, for a child in high school.
 - -lt takes \$150 support per month for a child in college.
- We need to raise \$8000 to construct another classroom building for Ebenezer Christian Academy.
- We need consistent support to run the operational costs of House of Hope Children Home.
 - -It takes \$2500 per month,

- for: feeding, rent, utilities, clothes, medical care, scholastic materials and staff wages.
- We plan to buy more land to grow our own food for the children's home. We need 4 more acres of land to meet our target, and each acre costs @ \$4000.

- We need 2 more sweater weaving machines to achieve our goal of sustaining the home. @ \$6000.
- We need support to run Ebenezer
 Christian school consistently:
 - -We need \$150 per month for rent.

- -We need \$3000 per month to pay teachers and workers.
- Pray that God will touch more people to join in to support our vision and transform our community.
