It is therefore important to educate a child in Uganda. Revival Outreach Ministries offers such hope for orphans and poor children in Uganda to go to school. \$35 a month is enough to make a dramatic change in the life of a precious child.

and shoes once every year, meets medical fees and buys breakfast & lunch.

great blessing to our community. It is much easier to construct the building than acquiring land. With this land, we will also be able to keep chickens and pigs. We appeal to you all our dear sponsors and friends to pray and support us to get this land. This man wants the land sold by the end of this year. We are praying about raising 60 sponsors who can contribute \$1000 each to make it easier to achieve our goal.

Prayer Requests

- ◆ We need to raise \$60,000 to purchase our own land where we can construct our school and children's home. This land will also help us to raise chickens and pigs for additional support and food.

- ◆ We need consistent support to run the operational costs of House of Hope Children's Home.

-It takes \$2500 per month for feeding, rent, utilities, clothes, medical care, scholastic materials and staff wages.

- ◆ We plan to buy more land to grow our own food for the children's home. We need 4 more acres of land to meet our target of growing vegetables and bananas and each acre costs @ \$4000.

- ◆ We still have a challenge of hundreds of children who have no opportunity to go to school.

-It takes \$35 support per month for a child in primary school

-It takes \$50 support per month, for a child in high school.

-It takes \$150 support per month for a child in college.

- ◆ We need support to run Ebenezer Christian School consistently:

-We need \$150 per month for rent.

-We need \$100 per month to pay teachers

- ◆ Pray that God will touch more people to join in to support our vision and transform our community.
