In 2012 we started Ebenezer Christian Academy to help equip orphans and poor children with quality Christian education in order for them to become godly future leaders that will transform their communities. Education is the only tool that will break the cycle of the bondage of poverty by equipping children with knowledge and skills to be self-sustaining when they grow up.

Because we were on was on rented land, we built the school as a temporary structure. Last year thanks to donors through Engage Hope Ministries we were able to purchase the land.

However, the government has now imposed that to keep the license; we must start construction of the permanent school buildings by November of this year and complete the construction next year. We cannot start the construction until this project is fully funded.



Currently we need over 116,000 to be funded. We have donors that are giving a \$30,000 match for each dollar donated. Our focus now is on building the school.

Christmas is around the corner!

A time to celebrate God's abundant love for the world. As a ministry we plan to make this season so special for every child in our community.

Every year we give an opportunity to our sponsors and donors to give a donation and help us reach out to our community and make Christmas both exciting and impactful.

This donation is three-fold:

1. A Christmas special need, usually to help the child and reach out to the entire family.
2. Buy a Christmas gift for the sponsored child.
3. Donate towards giving all the children a Christmas dinner.

Our staff usually carry out child visitation and need evaluation in the community and as a ministry we always come up with a special need drive every Christmas.

This gives an opportunity to sponsors to be a blessing to their sponsored children during the Christmas season but also make a difference in the life of the child and the entire family besides providing an education for the sponsored children. Usually Christmas

special need drive aims at enhancing development and sustainability in the community to help the child and her family be less dependent on aid and support.

It also gives a sponsor an opportunity to show the love of Jesus through giving and help make the children's life better.

This Christmas, our committee decided that we ask our dear sponsors and donors to give towards buying for each child a rainwater collection tank.

A lot of children help to fetch water for the family after school taking off from their evening study time. And most of the water sources available are creeks, which are usually so far away and takes about two hours and the children usually return after dark. Besides creek water here is so dirty causing diseases. And the children can't come to school when they are sick.

Good clean water promotes good physical health. This tank will help the child and her family to harvest clean rainwater during the rainy season which will be a great blessing to the family. Each tank costs \$30.

For sponsors that have more than one child in the family, you can give a donation for one water tank though you can also give more to help children whose sponsors will not be able to donate towards this need.

SPONSORED CHILD CHRISTMAS GIFT

Children always look forward to Christmas expecting to receive a gift from their sponsors no matter how small.



We usually ask sponsors to donate \$30 to buy shoes and clothes for the sponsored child. Any additional money can help other children in the family buy something special or plan to have a special meal as a family, however this is optional.

Also, in case you are able to mail a gift to Uganda; you have an opportunity to mail a Christmas package to your child through our mailing address.

Christmas gifts usually may include: School supplies like paper, pens, pencils, erasers, rulers, notebooks, story books. Toiletries like soap, toothpaste, toothbrushes, cream, deodorant, Soccer balls, Dolls. Note that it doesn't have to be a lot, shoe box is enough.

Such small things touch the hearts of children.

It would be great to send a Christmas card. Children are always happy to receive your family pictures; they love to show off their American family.

But for those who may want to mail packages and Christmas cards please use our mailing address and note that it takes about a month for mail to get to Uganda.

Most families in our community, eat one meal a day, most of the orphaned children and poor children do not know where their next meal will come from.

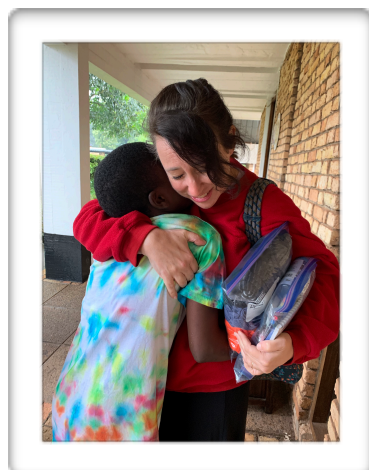
these poor

Kabale HOUSE Of HOPE

Kabale House of Hope has truly become a house of hope.



Half the population of Uganda is under the age of 15. A generation of parents died due to disease, famine, poverty and wars. Hundreds of children fill Uganda streets in search of food, love, a place to call home, education and hope. House of Hope has become a home for suffering orphans and homeless children. Today 35 children call House of Hope their home. The beauty of House of Hope is that all children blend together irrespective of

the different backgrounds and upbringing. Not only do we put a roof on their heads but we provide food, education, school supplies, care and love. Our children learn the Bibles every day and it's good to see them grow up into good disciples of Jesus. In future, we want to start a vocational school where our children can take classes in different skills and trades. Thank you, all our dear sponsors and donors that contribute to make, House of Hope a home for these children.

During the Summer Engage Hope trip, it was a joy to have a team of 20 people come to visit House of Hope. The children were very excited. During the visit the children were taught to make Tie Dye T-shirts.



Praise Lisa Reifschneider chose to sponsor John Baptist Kasigwa, one of the boys living at House of Hope but has been disabled by a disease that runs in their family. It has been a painful one year for Kasigwa until he could no longer be able to go to school. Thank God Lisa paid for him to have medication that reduced the pain. Plans are underway to see how best we can help John Baptist. His desire is to learn tailoring, then we can buy a tailoring machine for him and get him started off. Keep praying for him. We are so grateful to our faithful partners and donors who have been supportive to this amazing home since we started it in 2008.

The operational costs to run this amazing children's home is \$2500 per month. This basically pays for food, medical, maintenance, utilities, school supplies, staff wages and clothes

HOH TRANSITIONAL HOUSE

We are grateful to Pastor DuBayonne and Juvy Shortridge and the New Life Christian Church who came up with the vision of Hope Transitional House!



Our government changed policy and they are discouraging children living in the orphanages especially if they can find home elsewhere. When a child turns 18, he is considered an adult and would not be allowed to leave in an orphanage. Most of these children would find themselves on the street if we do not help them to get jobs and be able to be self-sustaining.

Our dream is to stick with them and take them through education then help them get jobs before we release them.

New Life Christian church came up with an idea of having a boy's

transitional house where boys above 18 can come and live as we take them through university, college or any trade. Our boys love this environment. It's great to see them transition into men. We have an amazing staff that helps them with bible study and counseling to help to them to make adjustments as they grow up. It's our joy to mentor these young men into good disciples of Jesus who will give back to the community.

In September two of older children Elijah and Ruth graduated with bachelor's degrees. Elijah did Business Administration and Ruth took Social works. It was such an honor! I am excited to see them go on with their lives and become the leaders God created them to be. What a joy to be a little part of their lives. We will help them find jobs and they will be on their own.

Bruce and Andrew were excited to join University this last semester. We can't wait to see what God has in store for them.

Our goal is to disciple all these boys into godly men during the time they spend at the Transitional House. We plan to help them complete education and learn skills so that they can be able to get jobs and become self-sustaining, and then they can be on their own.
